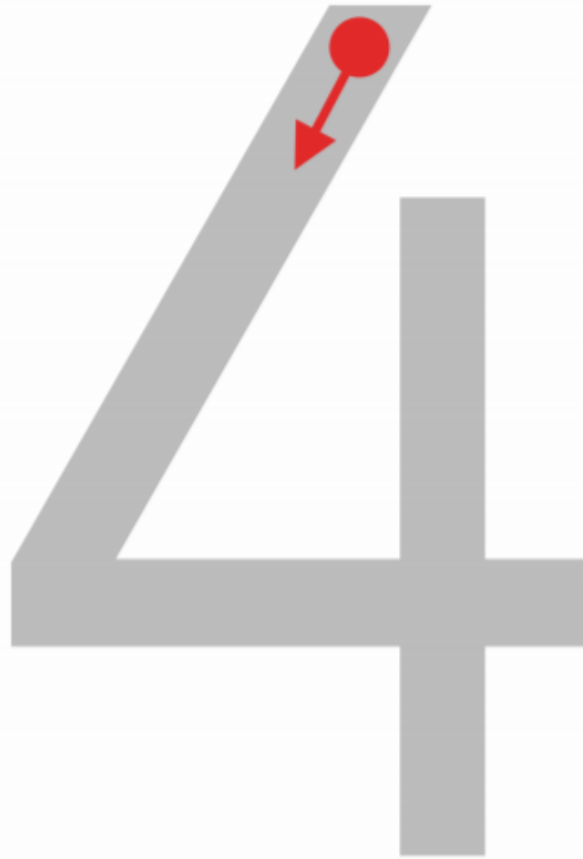
Miss Stevens Challenge Afternoon
