Today is: Friday 27th March

Today's tasks are (please see the timetable sent out previously for a recommended structure of the day however this is not a structure you need to follow for nursery but just guidance):

Pencil Control/Fine Motor Skills: Have a go at making some playdough. Can you mix the ingredients and knead the dough until its ready? Have a go at making an animal with your playdough (if you already have playdough they can just make an animal using that!) Find a playdough recipe here

Maths/Literacy: Today for maths I would like you to think about comparing the sizes of objects. Can you find the biggest and smallest flames (see resources at the end of this letter)? Can you put them in order and point to each one starting with the smallest/biggest? Can you find objects around your house and put them in an order of size/height/weight?

Phonics: Today's phonics is a phase 1 activity about rhyming. Can you spot the odd one out (see resources at the end of this letter)? Which ones rhyme? Which one is the odd one out? Can you think of another word that rhymes with it?

Topic: Can you watch the story video on the website – 'Pete the Cat – firefighter Pete'. Think about what he does as a firefighter. Can you discuss the story with your grown-up or older sibling – see resources at the end of this letter? Could you make a list of the different jobs a firefighter does? Ask your grown-up to write them for you or draw a picture of each thing they do.

Daily Challenges:

- Today's challenges are all games to play online – hopefully they won't need too much support with this and can be fairly independent in completing it.

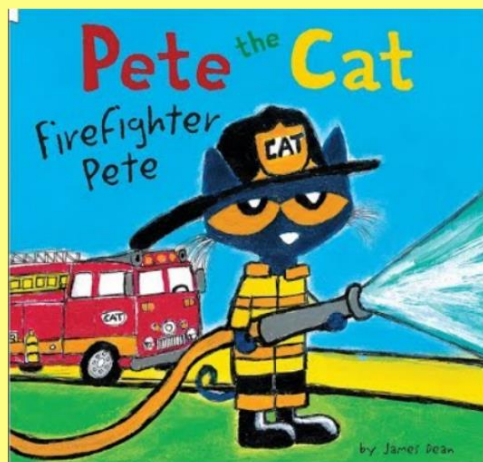
