Today is: Friday 3rd April

Today's tasks are (please see the timetable sent out previously for a recommended structure of the day however this is not a structure you need to follow for nursery but just guidance):

Pencil Control/Fine Motor Skills: Check out the video of 'Keep Fit Kiwi' featuring a real life Kiwi – Mr Wolfreys! Can you join in with the exercises? Also, I received an amazing photo of Teddy doing Cosmic Yoga – this looked like lots of fun and so I thought I would share it with all of you.

Maths/Literacy: Today for maths I would like you to use your number cards that you made on Wednesday and put them in order starting at 1 to make a numberline. Can you add your homemade numicon to your numberline? Can you fine objects and put the right amount to each number? Grown-ups: start exploring one more and one less by looking at the numberline and giving your child a number. EG: let's look at number 3, what is one less/what comes before? What comes next/this is one more.

Phonics: Can you sort the pictures into the right sounds? Can you find all the pictures that start with 's'? How about 'a'? Can you find objects around your house and sort them into different sounds?


