Today is: Monday 6th July

Today's tasks are (please note these activities can be done in any order and any preference. You do not need to complete them all but I have highlighted in yellow the activity that I feel is most beneficial.)

Pencil Control/Fine Motor Skills: We will be recapping some of the activities we have already done for fine motor skills over the next few weeks, with a few new activities popping up! Today's activity is using pegs.

See what you can use pegs for today – hanging out washing, racing game or maybe making a long line of joined up pegs.

Maths/Literacy: This week we will be looking at ordering numbers to 10. Write out the numbers 0 – 210 on paper or cards and cut them out so you have some number cards. Put them in order with your grown-up. Then ask a grown-up to mix up the numbers, don't peek whilst they are doing this. See how quickly you can put them back in the right order.

Maths step back: Start with numbers 1-5

Maths challenge: Work with numbers to 20 and even beyond if you can!

Phonics: Have a go at reading the CVC words at the end of this letter and drawing a line to the right picture

Phonics step back: Focus on practise sounds

Phonics challenge: can they put the word into a sentence

Topic: If you haven't already, please fill in the pupil survey with your child.

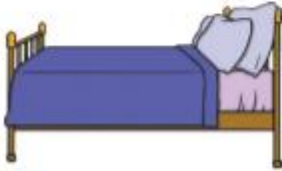
Daily Challenges:

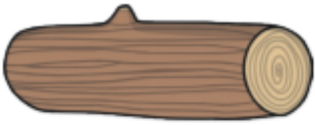
