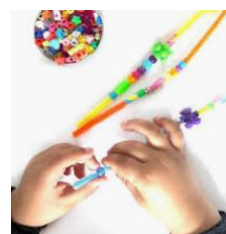

Today is: Thursday 14th May

Today's tasks are (please see the timetable sent out previously for a recommended structure of the day however this is not a structure you need to follow for nursery but just guidance):

Pencil Control/Fine Motor Skills: If you have pipe cleaners at home, I would like you to have a go at threading them. You can thread them through the holes on a colander, through the gaps in a pine cone or through holes punched into paper or card. If you don't have pipe cleaners, you can use ribbon, string or laces. You could even try to make a pine cone spider!



Maths/Literacy: Today I would like to challenge you to try and write some CVC words. Now this is a HUGE challenge and can be quite tricky. If you are finding it tricky just practise saying and writing your sounds. There are some sheets at the end of this letter to help you. After you have done those words, maybe you can think of your own words to try and write.

Topic: I would like you to think back to Norman the slug with his shell. Today I would like you to design a shell for Norman. What shape will it be? Will it be an object like a donut? What colour will it be and will it have a pattern on it? There is a template you can use at the end of this letter or you can draw your own slug and add the shell.

Daily Challenges:

- It's my birthday today so all of our challenges are birthday themed. Do you know anybody who has a birthday coming up? Can you make them a birthday card? What will you include?

- I turn 30 today, can you try and count up to 30. Can you count out 30 objects (it's quite a big number so you may need help)
