Today is: Thursday 18th June

Today's tasks are (please not these activities can be done in any order and any preference. You do not need to complete them all but I have highlighted in yellow the activity that I feel is most beneficial.)

Pencil Control/Fine Motor Skills: We will be recapping some of the activities we have already done for fine motor skills over the next few weeks, with a few new activities popping up! Today's activity is paper chains!

Today I would like you to have a go at making a paper chain. How long can you make yours?



Maths/Literacy: For literacy today I would like you to have a look at the picture at the end of this letter. Can you make up a story about the picture? What might be happening? Who might they be? Where might they be going? You could film your story or ask a grown-up to write it down for you.

Literacy step back: Look at the picture and describe what you can see, trying to use adjectives such as colours or sizes. Talk together about what might be happening.

Literacy Challenge: Have a go at writing some key words from your story or using some of our pirate vocabulary we looked at last week.

Phonics: Today we are going to think about initial sounds of some pirate words! You can watch a video here to learn with me: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=FU5xdFEV_RY or have a look at the slides below.

Phonics step back: Look at the pictures and focus on the names/vocabulary. Practise hearing initial sounds together such as b-b-b-boot.

Phonics challenge: Can you hear some other sounds in the word? Some of them are tricky so you might not hear them all. Have a go at writing 2 of the words.

Topic: Today is a pirate dot-to-dot. Think carefully about the numbers and which one comes next. I wonder what the picture will be.

Daily Challenges:

- Independent learning: Have a go at designing a pizza on Busy things. The game is under golden time (thanks to Eloise for this activity idea)

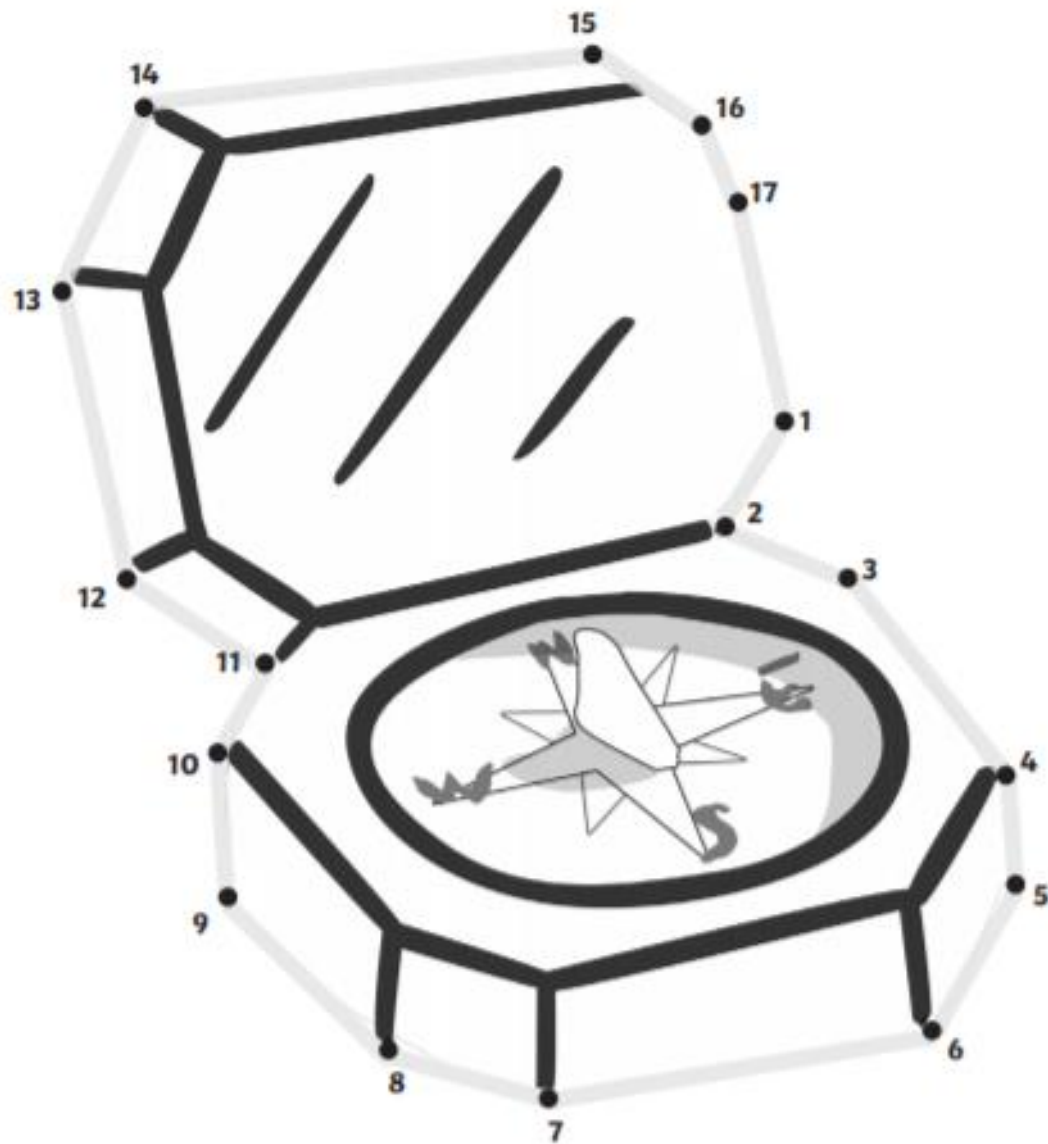

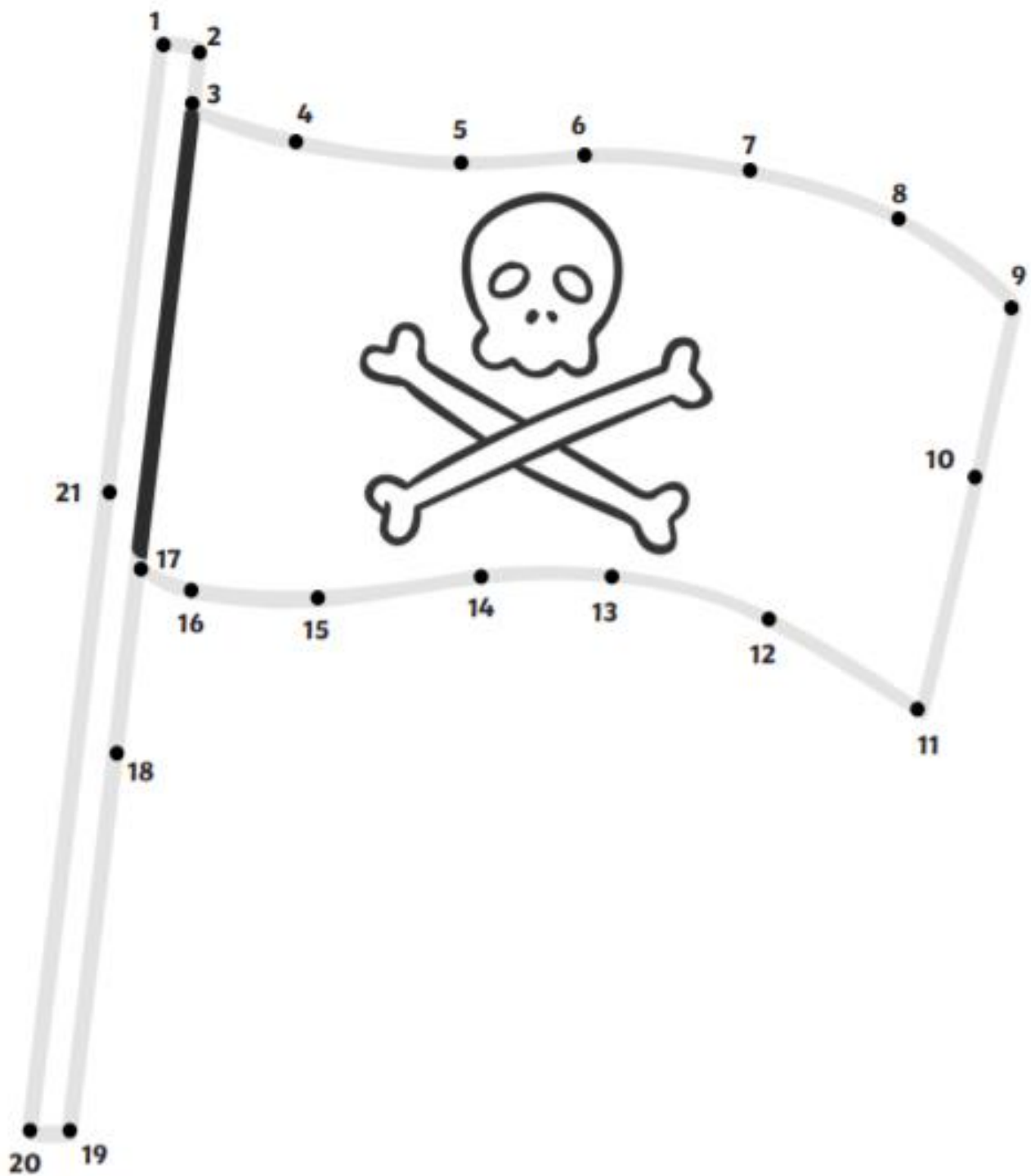

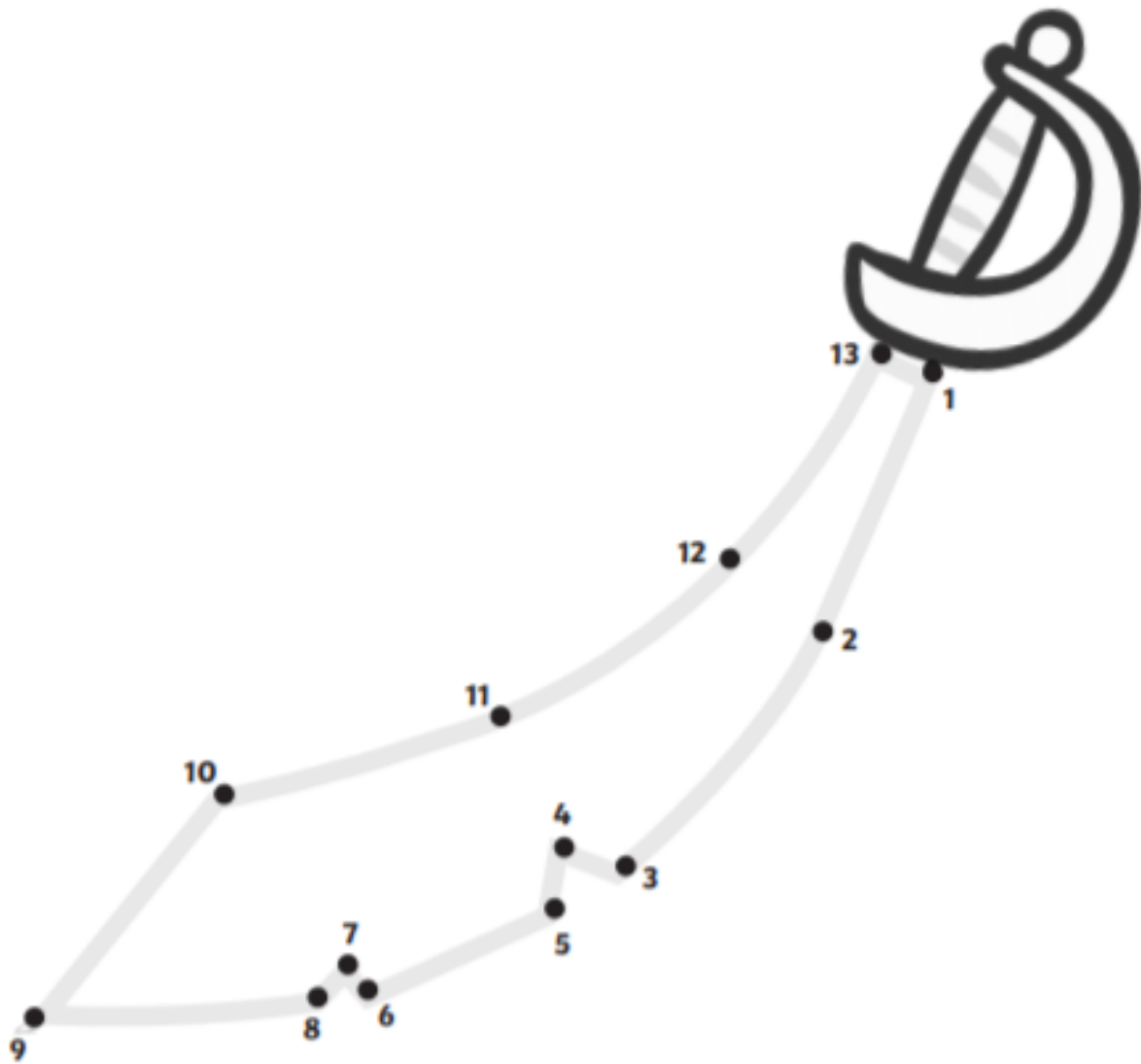
