Today's tasks are (please see the timetable sent out previously for a recommended structure of the day however this is not a structure you need to follow for nursery but just guidance):

Pencil Control/Fine Motor Skills: Today I am going to let you choose which activity you would like to do from all of the activities we have done so far. You might choose to use your tongs, play with playdough, thread some beads or weave some wool. You might choose to do something different! I wonder which one is your favourite?

Maths/Literacy: Today I would like you to draw me a picture of your favourite minibeast and say a sentence explaining why it is your favourite. Then I would like you to have a go at thinking of some describing words for your minibeast.

Phonics: Today I am going to ask you to do a little test on the sounds we have learnt. Please see the assessment sheet at the end of this letter. Show your child the sounds and if they know them put a tick in the box. If they say a different sound please put the sound they say in the box. If they don't know please leave the box empty. Please do not worry if your child does not know these sounds. They will learn them all in Reception again. It is just good for me to have a little understanding of where the children are.

Topic: Have a listen to this story <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=o6ZaSM6sNGw> It's all about a bear who wants to be a bee so dresses up as one. Can you have a go at designing an animal who is disguised as a bee? Maybe you will draw a bumble-zebra or a bumble-cat.

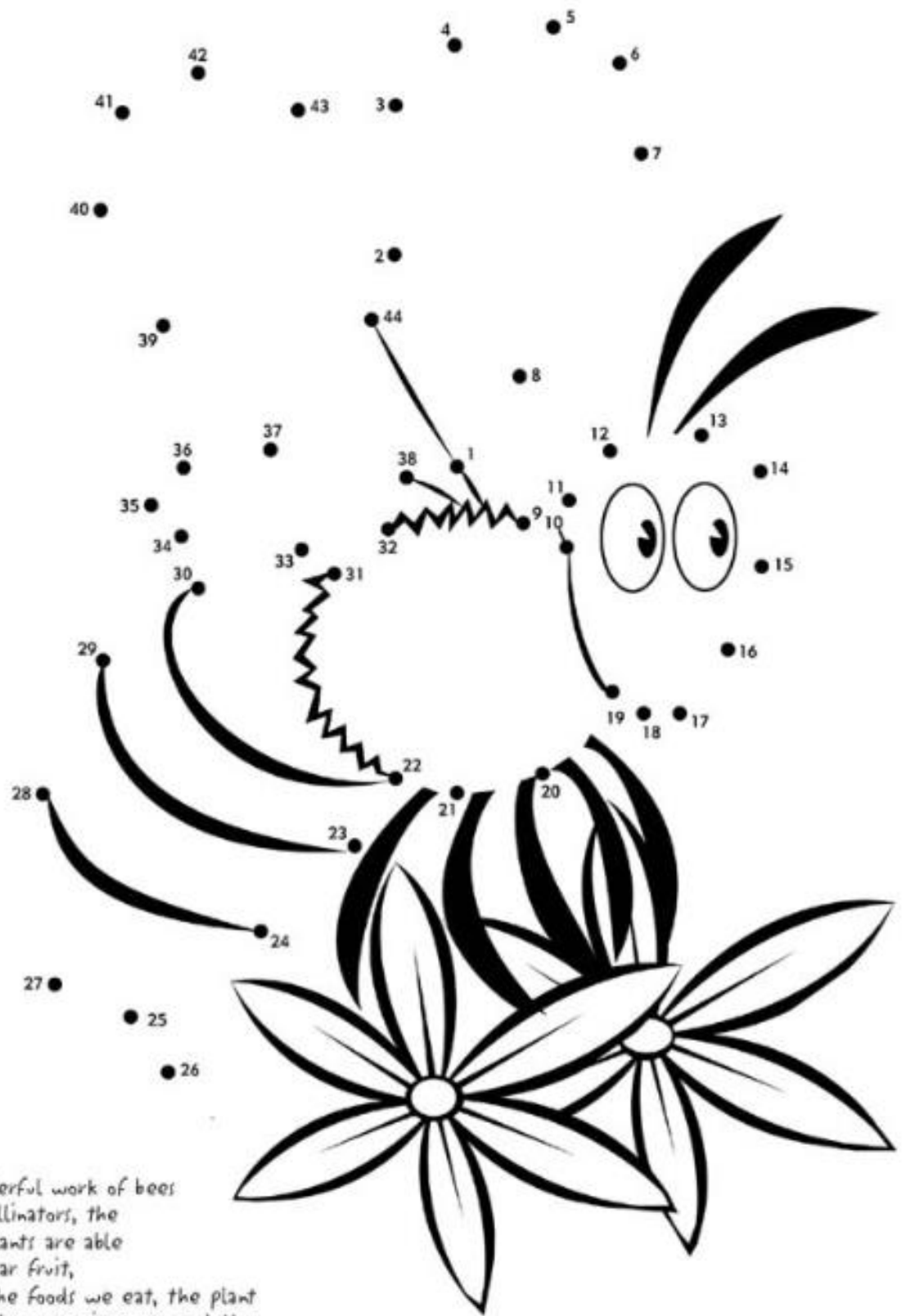
Daily Challenges:
