Today is: Thursday 7th May

Today's tasks are (please see the timetable sent out previously for a recommended structure of the day however this is not a structure you need to follow for nursery but just guidance):

Pencil Control/Fine Motor Skills: The sun should be shining today so today's activity is some water play. You can strengthen your fine motor skills using water play in so many different ways: pouring, stirring, squirting. Here are some ideas on what you could do.



Maths/Literacy: Today for literacy I would like you to practise writing our sounds. You can trace the sounds (at the end of the letter), copy them or try and write them from memory. If you are finding this easy, try writing some words like mum, dad, bat, pot, can etc.

Topic: Today I would like you to have another go at creating a pictogram, this time on whether a spider would make a good pet or not. Check out the slides and template at the end of this letter for help.

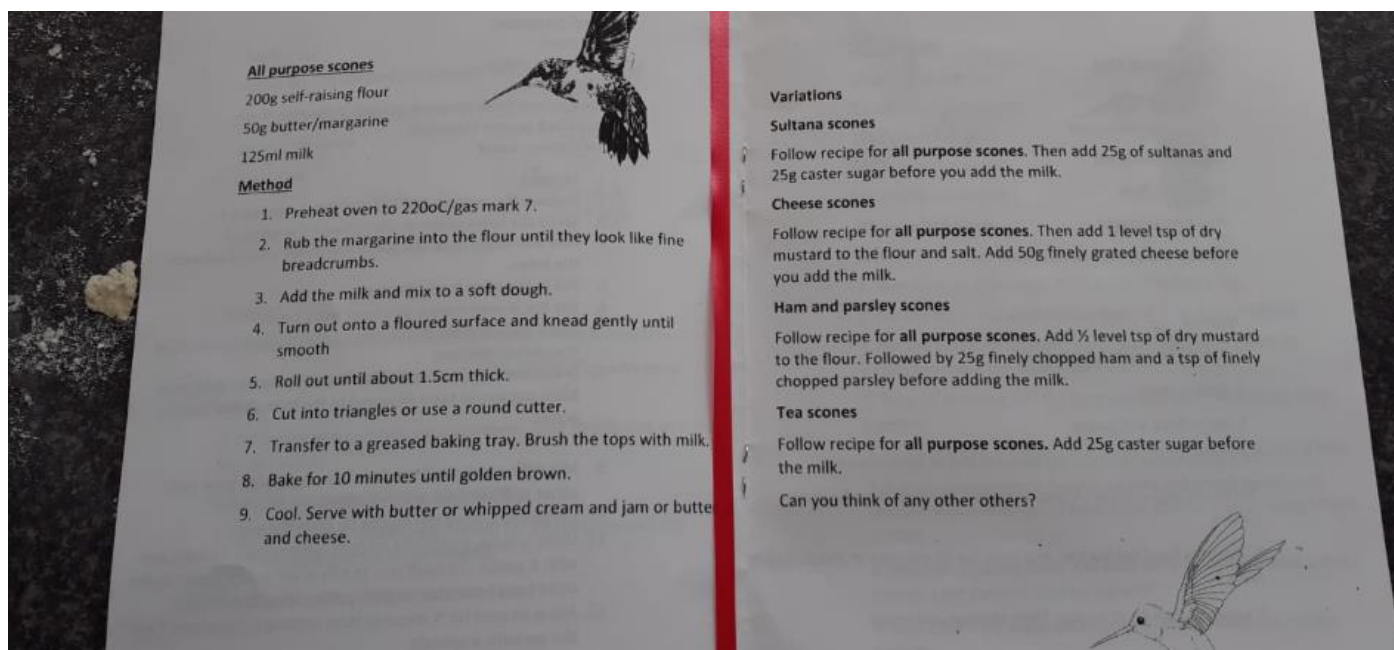
Daily Challenges:

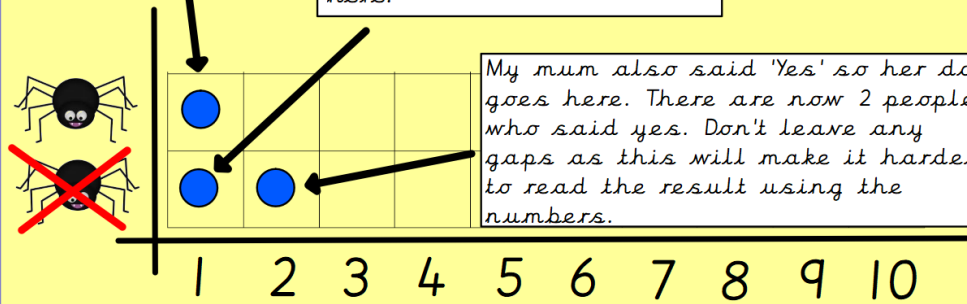
LC: I can create a pictogram

Mr Wolfreys said 'Yes' so his dot goes here.

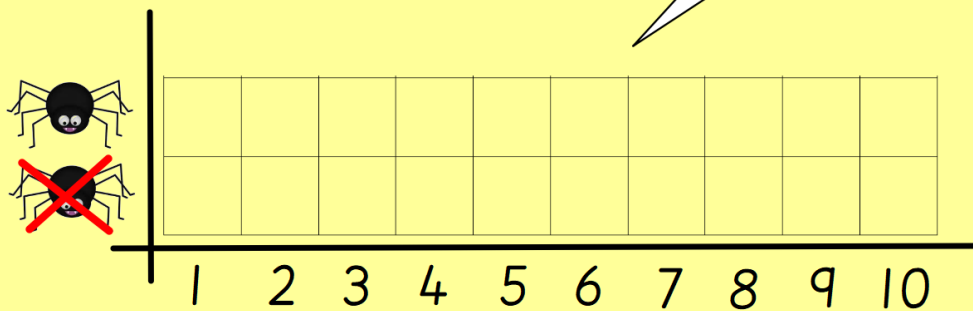
I said 'No' so my dot goes here.

My mum also said 'Yes' so her dot goes here. There are now 2 people who said yes. Don't leave any gaps as this will make it harder to read the result using the numbers.



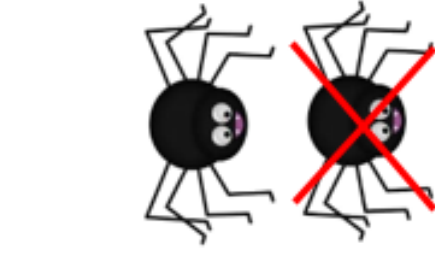
LC: I can create a pictogram
