Today's tasks are (please not these activities can be done in any order and any preference. You do not need to complete them all but I have highlighted in yellow the activity that I feel is most beneficial.)

Pencil Control/Fine Motor Skills: We will be recapping some of the activities we have already done for fine motor skills over the next few weeks, with a few new activities popping up! Today's activity is playdoh.

See what you can make with playdoh today. Maybe you can make your own dough to use!

Maths/Literacy: I want you to think about the following jobs, do you think a boy does this job or a girl?

Firefighter, nurse, doctor, astronaut, teacher, footballer, hairdresser and scientist. After, with a grown-up research these jobs and see if you can find both women and men who do the job. I think you will be able to because anybody can do any job they want to.

Linked with our topic lesson today and our story, I would like you to think about what you would like to be when you grow up. It is important to remember that you can be whatever you want to be. Can you draw me a picture of you grown up, doing the job you would like to do?


Topic: In our story yesterday, Red the crayon tried so hard to be good at being red but he just couldn't do it. That's when he realised he didn't want to be red because he was blue! It is important to remember that there will be some things that you are really good at and some things you find tricky. This is okay! Everybody has something they are good at and something they find tricky and these things will be different for each of us. I am good at drawing but Mr Wolfreys finds this hard, but Mr Wolfreys is good at playing the guitar and I have tried to learn but find it too tricky. Today, I want you to think about the things you are good at and the things you find a bit tricky. Ask your grown-up to do it too and maybe your brother and sister (if you have any). Are your things the same as theirs?

Daily Challenges:

- Independent learning: Draw a picture using crayons like in our story. Can you use the right colour for what you are drawing?
- Outdoor learning: Some outdoor maths today. Can you collect 10 objects from outside and then make your own sums by putting them into two piles. Which numbers add up to 10?
