Today's tasks are (please note these activities can be done in any order and any preference. You do not need to complete them all but I have highlighted in yellow the activity that I feel is most beneficial.)

Pencil Control/Fine Motor Skills: We will be recapping some of the activities we have already done for fine motor skills over the next few weeks, with a few new activities popping up! Today's activity is about using a knife and fork.

Today I would like you to have a go at cutting up some food. This could be your lunch or your dinner, or maybe you can help with some cooking and cut up some of the ingredients!

Maths/Literacy: Today I would like you to design a pizza to go with our story. What might you have on top of your pizza? Can you think of the shapes you could use for pepperoni or mushroom?

Literacy Challenge: Have a go at labelling your pizza. You can copy the words or try and sound some of them out. You could try to hear the first sound of each topping!

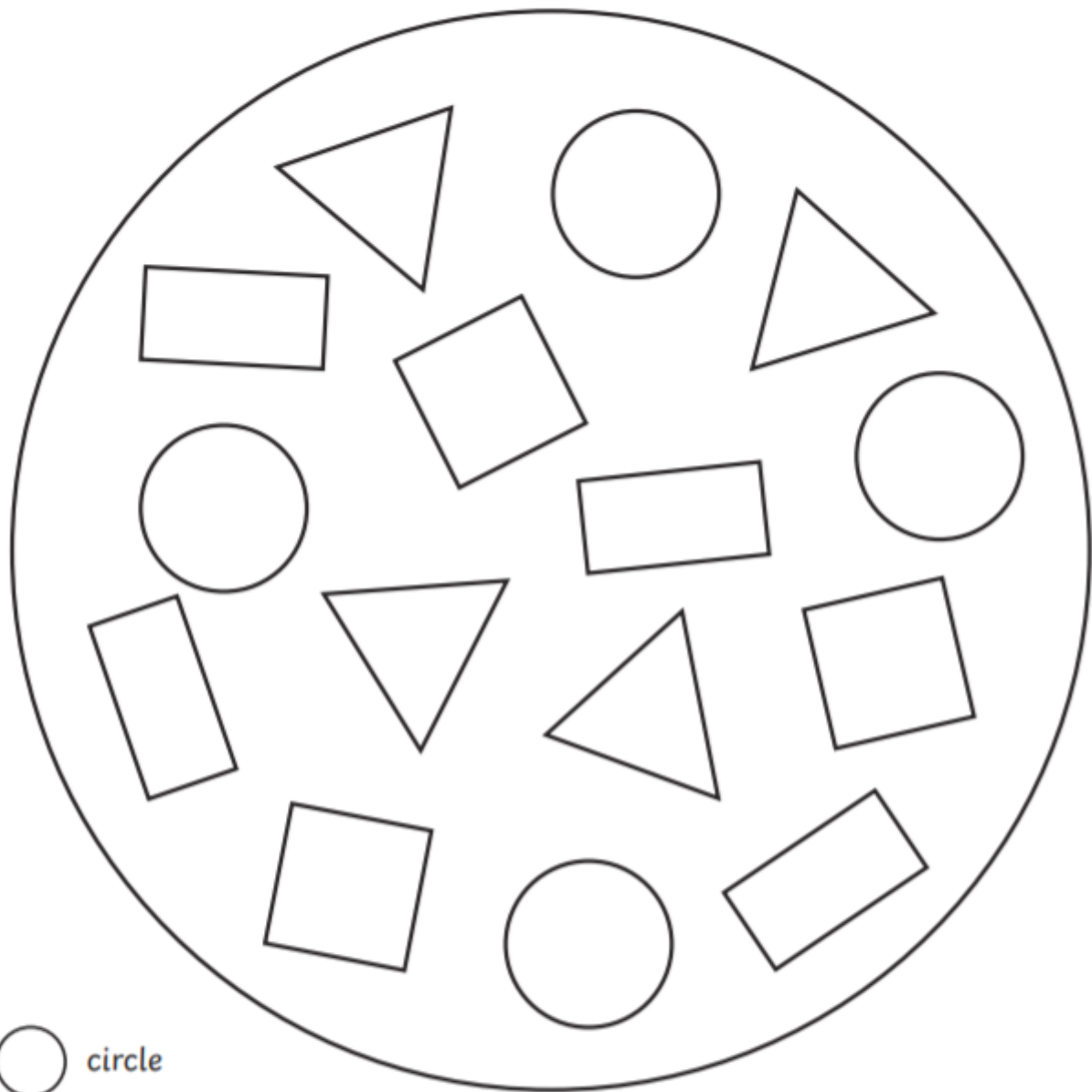

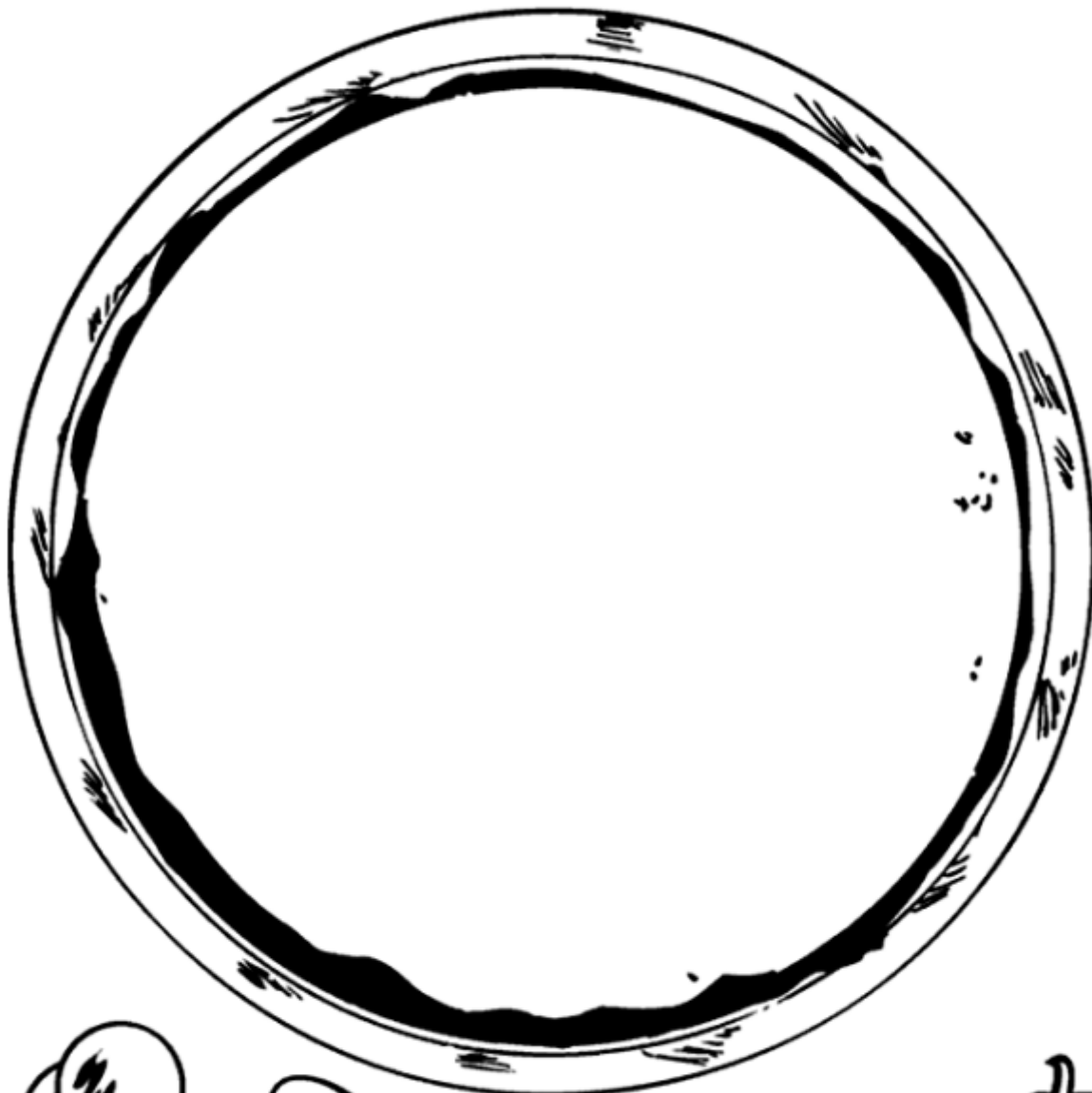
Pizza Shape Colouring
