Pencil Control/Fine Motor Skills: Today I would like to focus on our gross motor skills which are our big movements. I would like you to have a go at moving round like different minibeasts. How might a butterfly move? How about a slug? Have a look at the end of this letter for some ideas.

Maths/Literacy: Today for Literacy I would like you to have a go at creating a fact card for our bee. 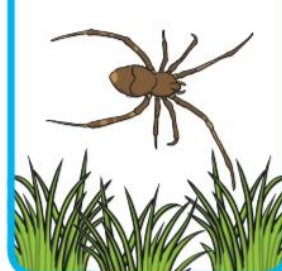

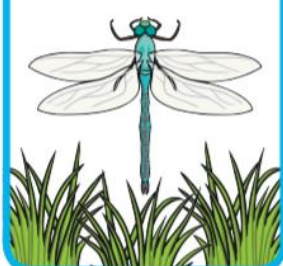

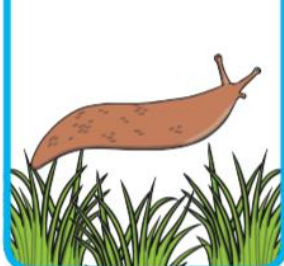

You can give bees a home by building a bee hotel in your garden.

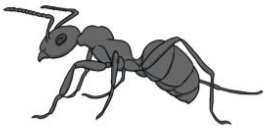
