Today's tasks are (please see the timetable sent out previously for a recommended structure of the day however this is not a structure you need to follow for nursery but just guidance):

Pencil Control/Fine Motor Skills: We will be doing some weekly dough disco. Dough disco is all about strengthening our fine motor skills using different movements with playdough to music. Topic: If you can, today I would like you to go on a bug hunt. What might you find? Maybe you could look in your garden or just outside your home.
