Pencil Control/Fine Motor Skills: Today I want you to your pegging skills by pegging the right amount of pegs to each numbered spider. There are some numbered spiders at the end of this letter or you could easily make your own by numbering cut out circles and using the pegs for the spider's legs.

Maths/Literacy: Today for Literacy I would like you to have a go at describing a spider. What does it look like? What might it feel like? How does it move? Check out the slides at the end of this letter to help you.

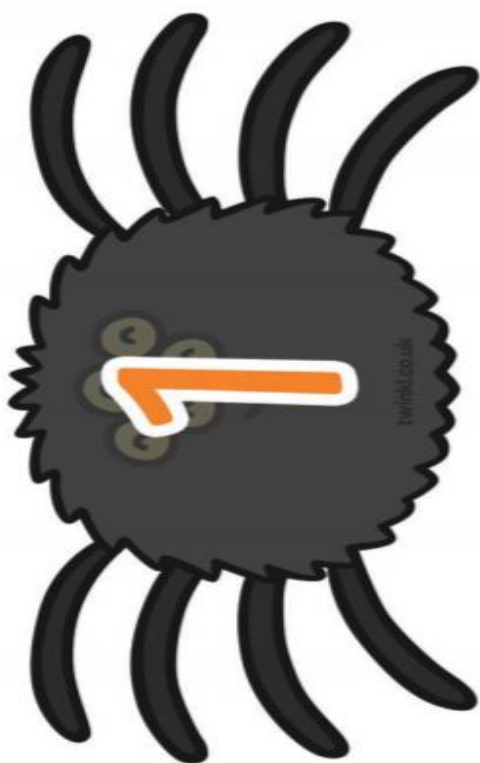
Daily Challenges:

- A forest school challenge today: Can you make a spider web outside in your garden or on your walk? Here are some examples:



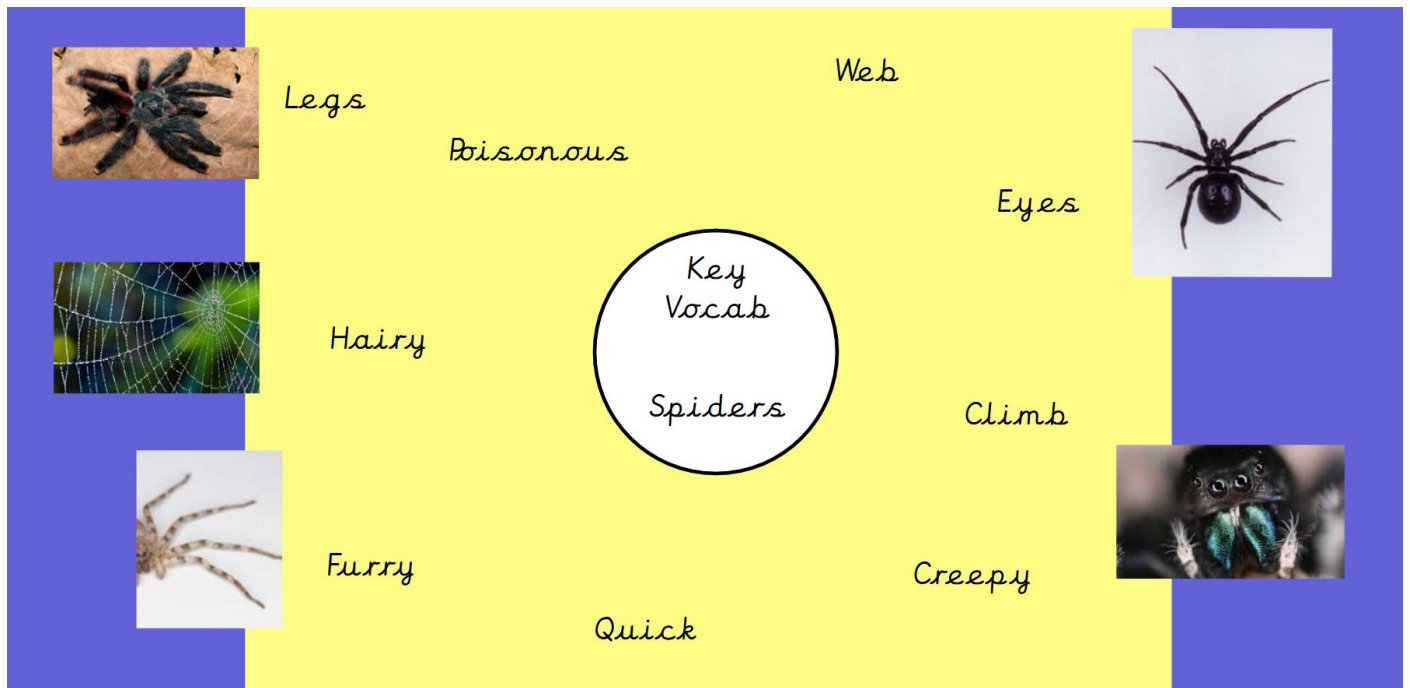
