Today is: Tuesday 9th June

Today's tasks are (please not these activities can be done in any order and any preference. You do not need to complete them all but I have highlighted in yellow the activity that I feel is most beneficial.)

Pencil Control/Fine Motor Skills: We will be recapping some of the activities we have already done for fine motor skills over the next few weeks, with a few new activities popping up! Today's activity is about clothing.

Today I want you to practise doing up zips, buttons and putting on shoes. If you can do this see how many times you can zip and unzip your coat in one minute!

Maths/Literacy: Today we will begin to look at money. Just like pirates have their doubloons, we have coins that we can use to buy things. Our first task is to explore some different coins. We will be focusing on 1p, 2p, 5p and 10p. Have a look at these coins and see what you can tell me about them. Think about their colour and size and what you can see on them. If you haven't got any coins at home, I have put some pictures of the coins at the end of this letter.

Maths step back: Focus on the language of size rather than looking for the numbers on the coins

Maths Challenge: Have a look at the amount of each coin. Can they work out how many 1ps they would need to make 2p, 5p or 10p? They will need support with the concept of this.









Rhyming Words
