Today is: Wednesday 1st April

Today's tasks are (please see the timetable sent out previously for a recommended structure of the day however this is not a structure you need to follow for nursery but just guidance):

Pencil Control/Fine Motor Skills: Today I want you to practise doing up zips, buttons and putting on shoes. If you can do this see how many times you can zip and unzip your coat in one minute!

Maths/Literacy: Today I want you to have a go at making your own set of number cards (you might already have some which will be fine to use for upcoming tasks!). What will your cards have on them? Try to include to numeral and a picture to represent it such as 2 cats or 5 dots. Can you make a set from 1-10?

Phonics: Today's phonics is a phase 1 activity about hearing initial sounds and alliteration. Ask your grown-up to read this story. Can you hear a lot of words that start with the same sound? When you have words that start with the same sound it is called alliteration. See if you can spot the sound and then all the words that start with that sound.

Colin the Caterpillar was cooking some carrot cakes. Colin had forgotten to buy carrots. Colin called his colleague Carter the Cow and asked him to collect the carrots. Carter collected the carrots from the corner shop. He also brought cookies, Coca-Cola and a cuddly cat. He got in his car and took the carrots to Colin. Colin and Carter cooked together. They looked at the clock to see when the cakes would be cooked. Then they ate the cakes together.

Topic: Today is April fool's day where we try and play pranks and jokes on someone like putting a toy spider in their drink or freezing their cereal in the bowl so they can't eat it. My favourite was eating a hard-boiled

egg, turning over the empty shell and giving it to my grown-ups pretending I had made them breakfast! Try and play a trick on one of your grown-ups today!

Daily Challenges:

- Can you find anything in your house that starts with the 'c' sound? I looked in my house and found a carrot, a clock and a candle. See if you can find more objects than I did!
- Recap all of our numbers by playing this numberblock game
