**Today's tasks are** (please not these activities can be done in any order and any preference. You do not need to complete them all but I have highlighted in yellow the activity that I feel is most beneficial.)

**Pencil Control/Fine Motor Skills:** We will be recapping some of the activities we have already done for fine motor skills over the next few weeks, with a few new activities popping up! Today's activity is weaving.









**Maths/Literacy:** Build a tower with 7 bricks. Can you build two more towers of bricks, one that uses one less than 7 bricks and one that uses one more than 7? Can you put these in an order? What do you notice? Try with some other numbers.

Maths step back: Focus on building towers looking at the language of size, short/small, big/tall, biggest/tallest, shortest/smallest.

Maths challenge: Try adding 2 more bricks. Can you work out the answer before adding the bricks?


