Today's tasks are (please see the timetable sent out previously for a recommended structure of the day however this is not a structure you need to follow for nursery but just guidance):

Pencil Control/Fine Motor Skills: Today I would like you to have a look at Mr P's Activity Avenue for PE. You'll find it on the website here: <https://www.meadlands.richmond.sch.uk/pe/> The Activity Avenue has links to many different websites and videos you can choose from to complete some exercise today. I wonder which one you will choose ...

Maths/Literacy: Today I want you to think about the shapes you know. Start by listening to the shape song on youtube: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=WTeqUejf3D0> Then have a go at playing this shape sorting game on top marks: <https://www.topmarks.co.uk/early-years/shape-monsters>. Can you spot any shapes in your house? What shapes are they?

Phonics: Time for another sound story all about the sound 'l'. Can you hear the sound? Can you spot the sound? Can you think of any other words starting with an 'l'? Can you write your own story using words that start with 'l'?
