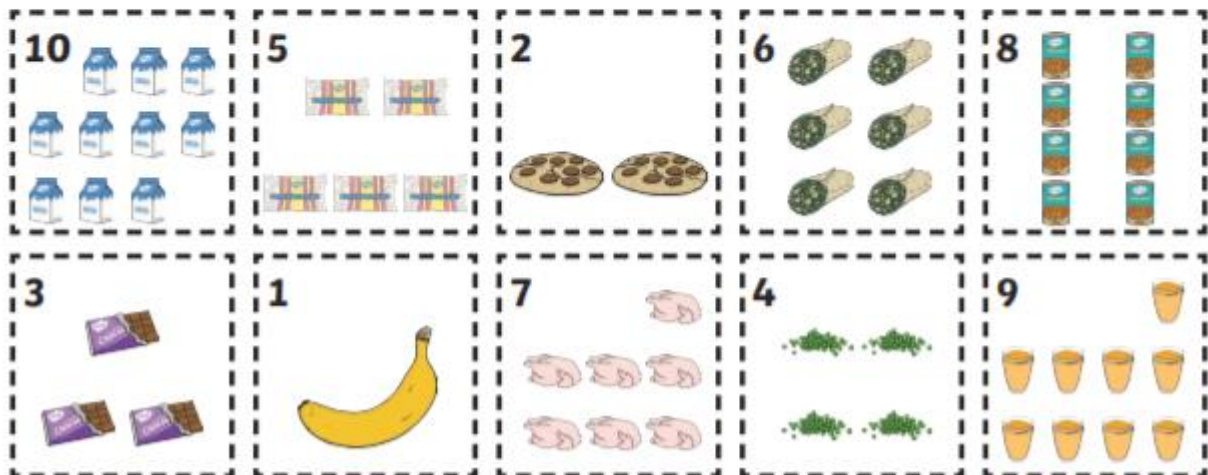
Topic: Think back to our story of the week. Watch it again if you need a reminder. Then have a go at discussing the questions at the end of the letter.

- Outdoor learning: explore different jumps today. See how high or how far you can jump. Jump with 2 feet together or leap with 1 foot first. Jump in different directions.

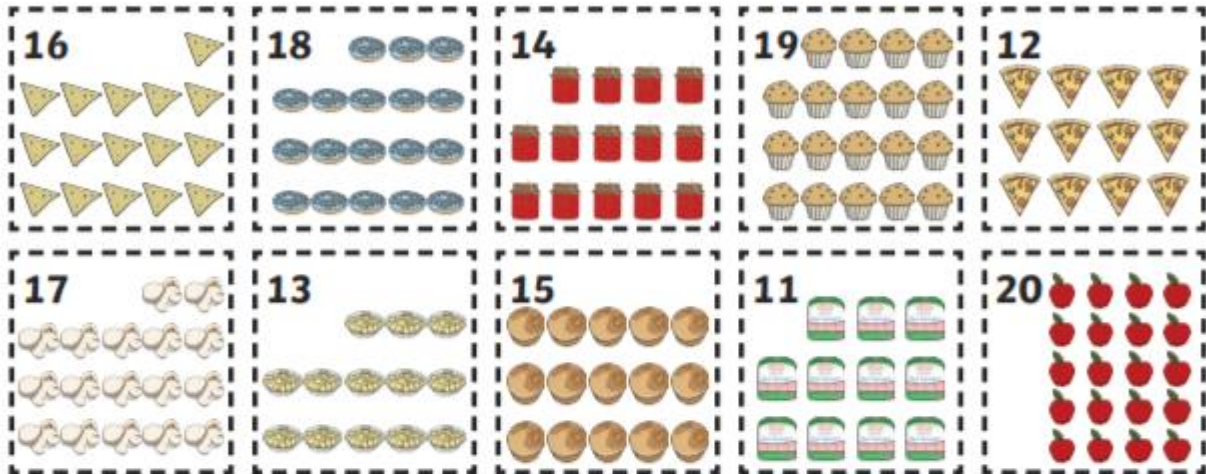

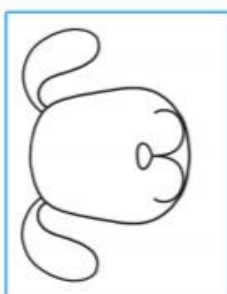
How to Draw a Dog



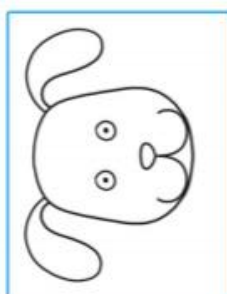
