What happened in the story?- Ask your child to recall the key events.

Who did we meet? - Focus on recalling the main characters.

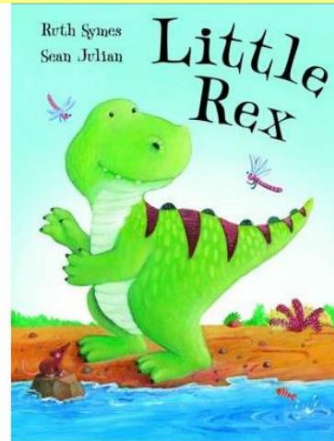
Why did he not like it when they called him

What were the noises that Rex heard?- The eggs hatching.

What type of dinosaur was Rex?- Tyrannosaurus Rex.



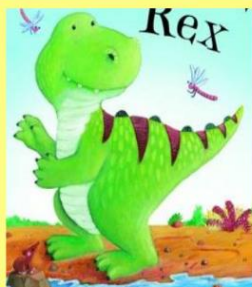
LC: I can describe Little Rex

EXT: What sound does it begin with?

Draw a picture of Rex in the middle and ask your parents to help you write some words to describe Little Rex.

Daily Challenges:
