Can you find a dinosaur in your home or another plastic toy, fill it up inside a cup or jug of water and leave it outside overnight.



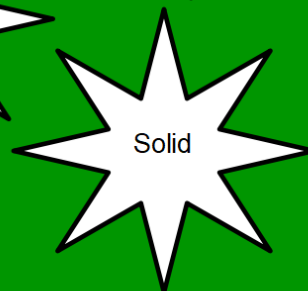
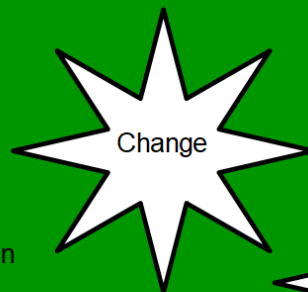
What do you think will happen to the toy?

Forest School Challenge

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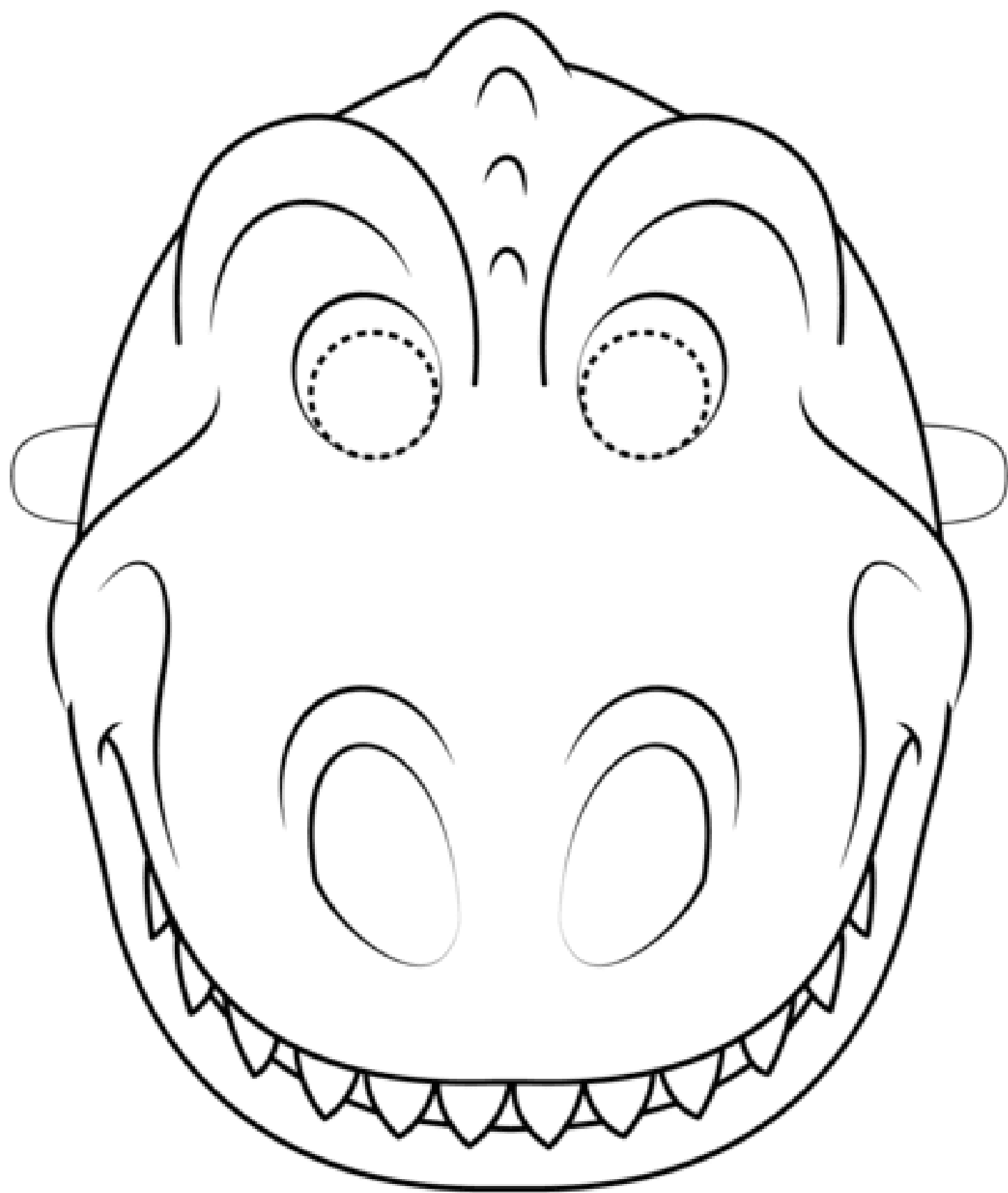
Can you use our wow words to talk about what you think might happen to the water and dinosaur?
