Biography

Fighting For Injustice

Dietrich Bonhoeffer was born on 4th February 1906. He is famous for helping the Jews and risking his life to fight for what was right. Bravely, Bonhoeffer resisted the Nazi regime through his Christianity. This relatively forgotten hero was born in Breslau, Germany. His birth place is now known as Wrocław, Poland. This saviour was very religious, which guided him to become a loyal and heroic man.

Early life and Education

Dietrich Bonhoeffer came from a non-religious family, who enjoyed music and art. In his early years, he displayed a musical talent and continued to show it throughout his life. To his parents surprise, at the age of 14, he decided to train and become a priest. This inspired

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him to study theology. He graduated at the University of Berlin.

Religious Life

In 1931 Bonhoeffer was ordained as a priest. He was outraged by the treatment of the Jews and did not stand for discrimination. He stuck to his faith and built a Confessing Church in 1933 to oppose the Nazi regime. The Nazis were agitated and the church was sadly closed down. But Bonhoeffer was determined to fight on.

Involvement in resistance

Bonhoeffer made a radio broadcast in 1933 but it was cut off mid-sentence by the Nazis because they did not approve any resistance. He travelled to the USA in 1939 but returned to Germany in 1941 and joined the Abwehr. Undaunted by the dangers he faced, he courageously helped huge numbers of Jews to escape over the border to Switzerland. This eventually led to his arrest in 1943.
