Parent Promise Policy

The following statements have been written by the children. These are their expectations and wishes of how parents should help their children and support the school when starting with us here at Meadlands.

As a Meadlands parent, I promise to:

1. Make sure my child goes to bed early on a school night.



2. Make sure the school office has at least 2 emergency contacts and these details are up to date.
3. Be a respectful and polite visitor in and around the school and towards staff and other parents.
4. Help keep the school environment safe.
For example: keeping dogs on a lead and not bringing them on to the school premises.



5. Make sure my child's bag is packed the night before. This will include: a morning snack (fruit only), a healthy packed lunch, a pencil case (no rubber), books and importantly 20p on Treat Friday.



6. To follow the school uniform policy and make sure my child looks smart in their school clothes and PE kit. I also promise to label my children's school clothes.
7. Always help my child with their homework but I promise not to tell them the answers and make sure this is ready to be handed in on Wednesday.

8. Listen to my child read between 10 -20 minutes every day and sign the white reading record at least once a week if my child has one.



9. If my child has a worry or is unhappy I promise to work with my child's class teacher to make it better.
10. Help my child to understand what is and isn't bullying (so I promise to read the school's behaviour policy)
11. Walk, scoot or cycle to school with my child. I will try to avoid driving unless I live far away. If I do drive, I promise to park safely. If I do scoot I promise to walk with my scooter/bike once on the school grounds
12. Make sure my child arrives on time before the gate is locked.
13. Make sure I collect my child on time after school and after clubs or events.



14. Let my child's teacher know if somebody else is picking me up at the end of the day.
15. Keep my child at home if they are poorly and follow the school's rules on reporting sickness.
16. Make sure my child uses technology appropriately and safely.
17. Play games with my child (when I can).
18. Where possible attend the Friday book looks, teacher meetings, assemblies and performances and try to go on 1 school trip.



19. Read the weekly newsletter, bulletin and Parent Mail and action any requests or forms.
20. Try to join and support the PTA and help school events.

The children have also written 6 promises for the children:

As a member of the Meadlands Family, I promise to:

1. Work my hardest and always be kind.
2. Follow the school values, these are about being: motivated, imaginative, independent, resilient, curious, kind, ambitious and using my initiative.
3. Ask for help when I need it.
4. Read every day.
5. Be a Meadlands Warrior, know that mistakes are part of learning and often lead to the greatest progress.
6. Keep myself and help to keep others safe and look after school resources.
